Medicare Advantage and Part D Marketing Rules.

Keep in mind that insurance companies selling Medicare private plans must follow certain rules when promoting their products. These rules are meant to prevent plans from presenting misleading information about a plan's costs or benefits, also know as marketing violations.

There are things that agents cannot do.

1. Call you if you did not give them permission to do so.

2. Visit you in your home, nursing home, or other place of residence without your invitation.

3. Provide gifts or prizes worth more than \$15 to encourage you to enroll Gifts or prizes worth more than \$15 must be made available to the general public, not just people with Medicare.

4. Disregard federal and state consumer protection laws for telemarking, the Nation Do-Not-Call registry, or do-no-call-again request.

5. Imply that they are calling on behalf of Medicare.
